Meeting was called to order by Chair Reibe with the following Park Commissioners present: Sagedahl, Trautsch, Nelson, Gilberts, Hoffland, Kramer

Motion by Hoffland, second by Gilberts to approve open certification requirements. Motioned carried

Motion by Nelson, second by Trautsch to approve April 22nd minutes, Motioned carried

Motion by Nelson, second by Sagedahl to approve Paula and Randy Shecklers request to donate up to \$2500 for a new swing set unit for Washington Street Park. The city would assist in the costs of a certified playground installation with moneys coming from Park Improvement Fund .Motioned carried.

Motion by Trautsch, second by Gilberts to approve Tony and Sue Rangels request to have an Oktoberfest Event at St. Feriole Gardens on October 16th as a means to promote and raise monies for the gardens subject to council approval and having all proper permits, fees, and insurance. Motion carried with Tom Nelson abstaining

Motion by Nelson second by Sagedahl to approve Villa Louis Carriage Classic event on St. Feriole Island for September 10-12th subject to council approval and having proper permits, fees, and insurance. Motioned carried

Motion by Hoffland second by Nelson to approve Darci Collins request to hold a Women's Fire Department Auxiliary sponsored Fish Fry and Street Dance at St. Feriole Island on September 25th subject to council approval and all permits, fees and insurance. Motion carried

Tom Nelson updated the board on the many good things happening on the island and commended city crews for helping the Island look great!

Ivan Hoffland updated the Board on LaRiviere Park with Memorial Day weekend very busy with over 100 units and the open house being well received. The first graders from BA Kennedy also had a wonderful field trip at the park.

The Director informed the board of Hoffman Halls Feasibility Study and well received 3 days of interviews. All pertinent information from the interviews is currently being processed and will be reported to Parks, Hoffman committees and Council on July 20th.
