Hoffman Hall's 40,000 square feet include a heated Olympic-size indoor pool and locker rooms; a gymnasium; a meeting and concessions area to accommodate up to 100 people; an aerobic/fitness room with mats, mirrors, hand weights, and other exercise equipment. The facility is used by youth, adults, seniors, civic organizations, and school sports teams for a variety of community programs and special events.
